



## APPLICATION GUIDELINES

**PURPOSE:** The **14<sup>th</sup> Hour Foundation Fund** was created to provide **Honor Grants** to the individuals and immediate families of those who have served and sacrificed to protect the American Homeland, which extends to federal agencies and departments that preserve and secure human lives within and outside the United States of America. This fund also will support charitable organizations that promote awareness of the same.

Individuals and immediate families of individuals that served and sacrificed to protect the American Homeland too often have needs in the months and years following a related injury or death. For that person or that family, the 14<sup>th</sup> Hour Foundation is there in their hour of need.

### **ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES:**

- U.S. Citizens who have served and sacrificed to protect the American Homeland.
- Non-profit organizations in good standing with the same mission as The 14<sup>th</sup> Hour Foundation.

### **APPLICATION PROCESS:**

1. Complete a 14<sup>th</sup> Hour Foundation Fund Grant Application.
  - a. A grant application form must be completed and returned to The 14<sup>th</sup> Hour Foundation Fund at [kpillc13@gmail.com](mailto:kpillc13@gmail.com).
  - b. All applications must be typed or printed from an electronic application (Microsoft Word). No handwritten grant applications will be accepted.
  - c. All questions on the application form should be answered. Supporting documents are required.
2. Include supporting documents.
  - First Responders, Military Personnel, Families and Contractors:
    - DD-214, if retired (must have an Honorable Discharge) (Military)
    - VA Award Letter, if retired (Military)
    - VA or Photo ID (Military)
    - LES, if active duty (Military)
    - Proof of Injury, if active duty (Military)
    - Pay Stubs (all)
    - List of Contracts with dates and Contracting firm deployed with or worked for (Contractors ONLY)
  - Most recent Federal tax return filed.
  - All applicable invoices, bills and/or receipts for requested support.

When all of the requested items are provided, The 14<sup>th</sup> Hour Foundation Fund will review and respond to the applicant within a timely manner. Please monitor your email for any additional information pertaining to the grant request.
