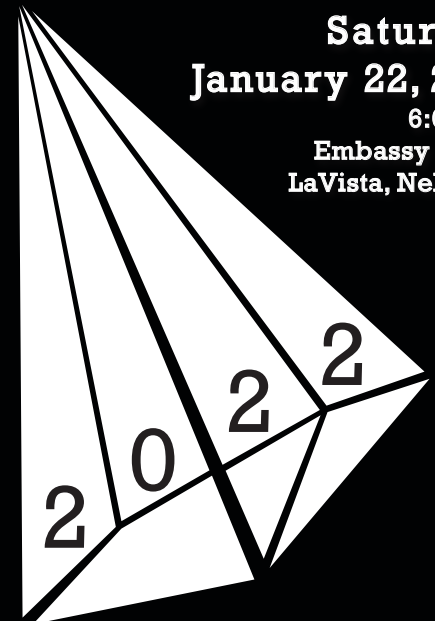

The 2022 Reflection Award recipients are Cathie and John Fullenkamp for their untiring commitment and dedication to community growth.

John graduated from Creighton University School of Law in 1970 and is admitted to practice law in NE and IA (inactive).
