Purpose: The Sarpy County Bar Association Scholarship Fund makes this scholarship available to students studying criminal justice, criminology, sociology, psychology, or pre-law.

Award: The Fund shall annually distribute two (2) scholarships in the total amount of \$1,500, split evenly per semester (i.e., \$750 Fall Semester, and \$750 Spring/Semester).

CRITERIA:

- a. Be a current, graduating high school senior: or
b. Be enrolled full time (minimum 12 hours) in undergraduate study at an institution of higher learning; and
c. Can't have completed more than 3 years of higher education at an accredited higher learning institution.
d. Must enroll to major or is currently majoring in criminal justice, criminology, sociology psychology or pre-law.

Selection of the scholarship recipient shall be made from the qualifying applicants of the above-identified charitable class, based on the following criteria:

- a. The recipient must show financial need.
b. The recipient must show exemplary community service.
c. The recipient must show active volunteerism.
d. A letter from the high school office stating that the applicant is in the top 50% of class or maintains a standard GPA of 2.5.
e. Submission of the application by the deadline date.
f. Submission of a verification of the student's semester grades and continued enrollment in high school or the institution of higher learning.

The committee will weigh the above criteria along with the consideration as applicable below:

- a. Financial Need: 25%
b. Class Standing or Grades: 25%
c. Exemplary community service 20%
d. Active Volunteerism: 15%
e. A child, stepchild, grandchild, or a ward of the state of dues paying member of Sarpy County Bar Association member: 15%
